 - a) procure the de-registration of the aircraft from the Kuwait Register of Civil Aircraft maintained by the Directorate General of Civil Aviation for the purposes of Chapter III of the Convention on International Civil Aviation, signed at Chicago, on 7 December 1944, and
 - b) procure the export and physical transfer of the aircraft from the State of Kuwait; and
- ii. confirmation that the authorised party or the person it certifies as its designee may take the action specified in clause (i) above on written demand without the consent of the undersigned and that, upon such demand, the authorities in the State of Kuwait shall co-operate with the authorised party with a view to the speedy completion of such action.

The rights in favour of the authorised party established by this instrument may not be revoked by the undersigned without the written consent of the authorised party.
